Ergonomic assessments can be conducted in a range of environments from driver positioning to office workstations and can be an effective component of a solid injury prevention strategy.

An ergonomic assessment differs from a worksite assessment in that it is not ordinarily an evaluation of pre-injury and potential suitable duties. an ergonomic assessment can be an expedient and cost effective measure returning an injured employee to work where workplace modifications are required to assist an injured worker to maintain their pre-injury duties.
